## WXXI CLASSICAL MEMORIES

As we continue down FM 91.5's Memory Lane we find many great moments that happened in May.

- 1 Tom Bartunek became WXXI-FM's Manager in May 1978, and current WXXI Classical Morning host Brenda Tremblay joined WXXI in 1991.
- 2 May 1978 also saw a live remote outside the studios on State Street in celebration of *Simon's Super Scintillating Sunshine Show*: "WXXI FM 91.5 Celebrates Sun-Day."
- 3 On May 16, 1994 *Fascinatin' Rhythm* host Michael Lasser (pictured) and Audio Engineer Dave Sluberski made their way to the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel in New York City to receive a Peabody Award.
- 4 In May 17, 2014 the RPO performed at Carnegie Hall – for the 17th time, but the first in nearly thirty years. The RPO presented a concert production of *Merry Mount*, the only opera written by the late Howard Hanson, renowned composer and director of the Eastman School of Music. It was commissioned by and made its highly successful world stage premiere at NYC's Metropolitan Opera in 1934, and still holds the world's record for the most curtain calls—50—at that historic venue.
- 5 And just for fun, on May 2, 1993, this cartoon of Simon Pontin in the studio appeared in "Mitchell's View" of the *Democrat and Chronicle*.
