WXXI CLASSICAL MEMORIES

As we continue down FM 91.5's Memory Lane we find more great moments that happened in July

As public radio was beginning to grow throughout the country, so were the program offerings made available to stations from NPR and other stations & distributors. It soon became apparent that if WXXI wanted to provide the best service to the greater Rochester community, WXXI would need another outlet for these programs.

On July 2, 1984, WXXI launched its second radio station - AM 1370, as a public affairs, news and jazz station, making it possible for FM 91.5 to convert to a "mostly" classical music format. There was still a variety of programming, including Sounds Like Fun, A Prairie Home Companion, Essence of Jazz, Anything Goes (later Fascinatin' Rhythm), Adventures in Good Music with Karl Haas (pictured left top), and the always unpredictable Sunshine Show, complete with arts reviews and commentaries.

The very first commentator on Simon Pontin's Sunshine Show was that of Homer King (a.k.a.
