Remembering Michael Lasser

Michael Lasser, a long-time host of the nationally syndicated music show Fascinatin' Rhythm (formerly Anyhing Goes) passed away on Tuesday, July 22 at age 89. A graduate of Dartmouth College, Michael was a broadcaster, writer, lecturer, critic, and teacher. In 1994, Fascinatin' Rhythm won a prestigious George Foster Peabody Award, and, in

2010, he was named a Thomas P. Johnson Distinguished Visiting Scholar at Rollins College.
