#### **Youth Media Opportunities**

Announcing the launch of FRONTLINE Short Docs, a new series by PBS' trusted source for investigative journalism and documentaries. These short, boldly-told documentaries explore critical issues that impact young adults and the world they live in.

Available on PBS LearningMedia, and produced with input from teachers and students, these 5-10 minute films highlight the personal stories and experiences of young adults while offering excellent springboards for reflection, analysis, and understanding across social studies subjects.

Utilizing months-long research and analysis, FRONTLINE Short Docs is the product of surveys, focus groups and interviews conducted to better understand teens' current news media viewing habits. FRONTLINE and GBH Education assembled a diverse Youth Advisory Council of teen students to provide feedback on each episode and the stories featured in FRONTLINE's new series. GBH Education also tested the series with high school teachers and their students to examine and refine the Short Docs and curriculum materials for classroom use.

This pilot season of FRONTLINE Short Docs will be published on PBS LearningMedia over the next several weeks.



The Medicine Game airs 11/5 at 5 p.m.—a film six years in the making, shares the remarkable journey of two brothers from the Onondoga Nation driven by a single goal-to beat the odds and play the sport of lacrosse for national powerhouse Syracuse University. The Onondaga Nation, tucked away in central New York State, is a sovereign Native American community known to produce some of the top lacrosse players in the world. The Iroquois people play a ceremonial game of lacrosse, referred to as the "medicine game" - a very important medicine ceremony played to ward off sicknesses from the tribe. The obstacles in the brothers' way are frequent and daunting, but their love for the game, each other, and their family's unyielding determination propels these young men towards their dream.






