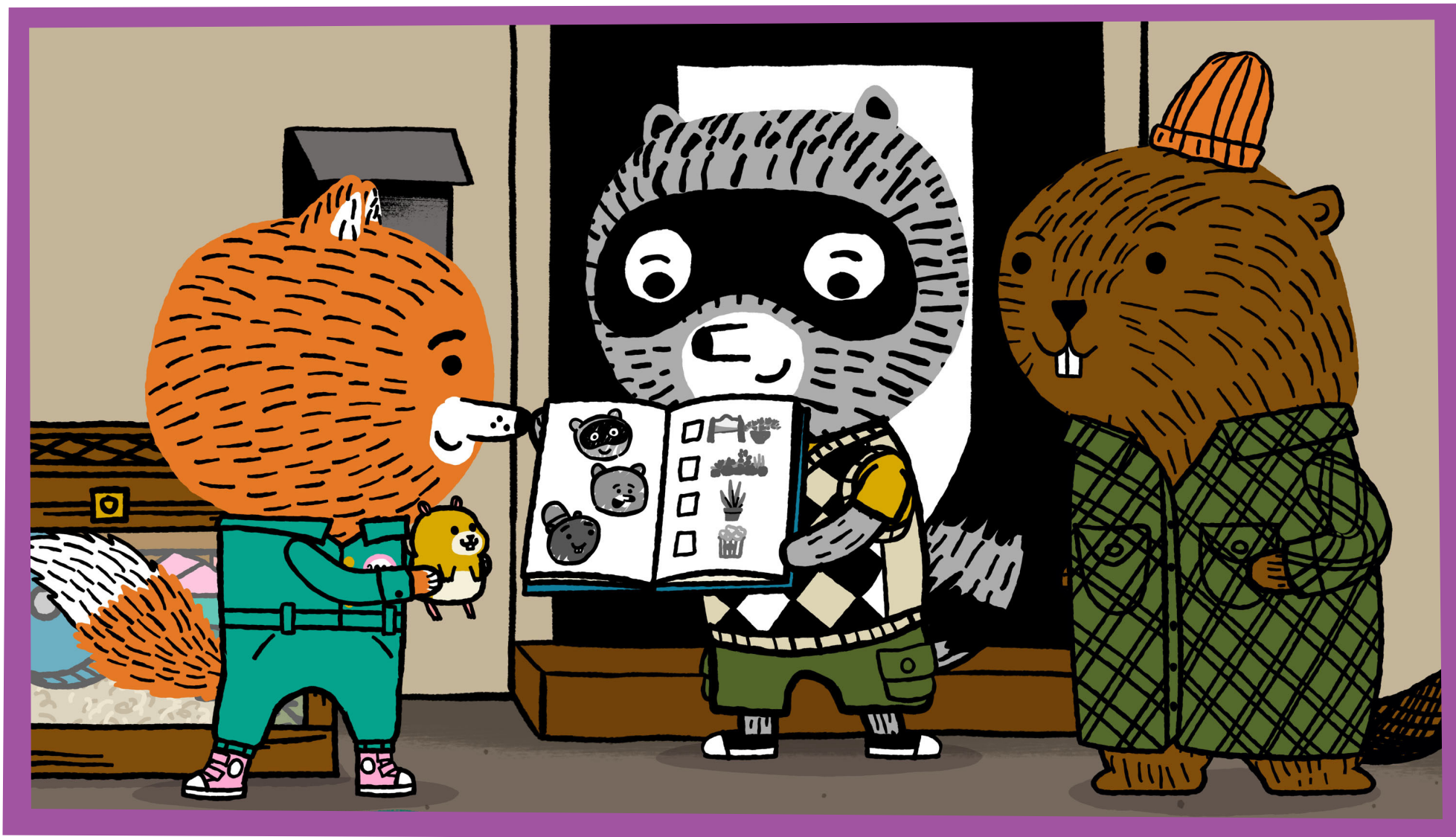

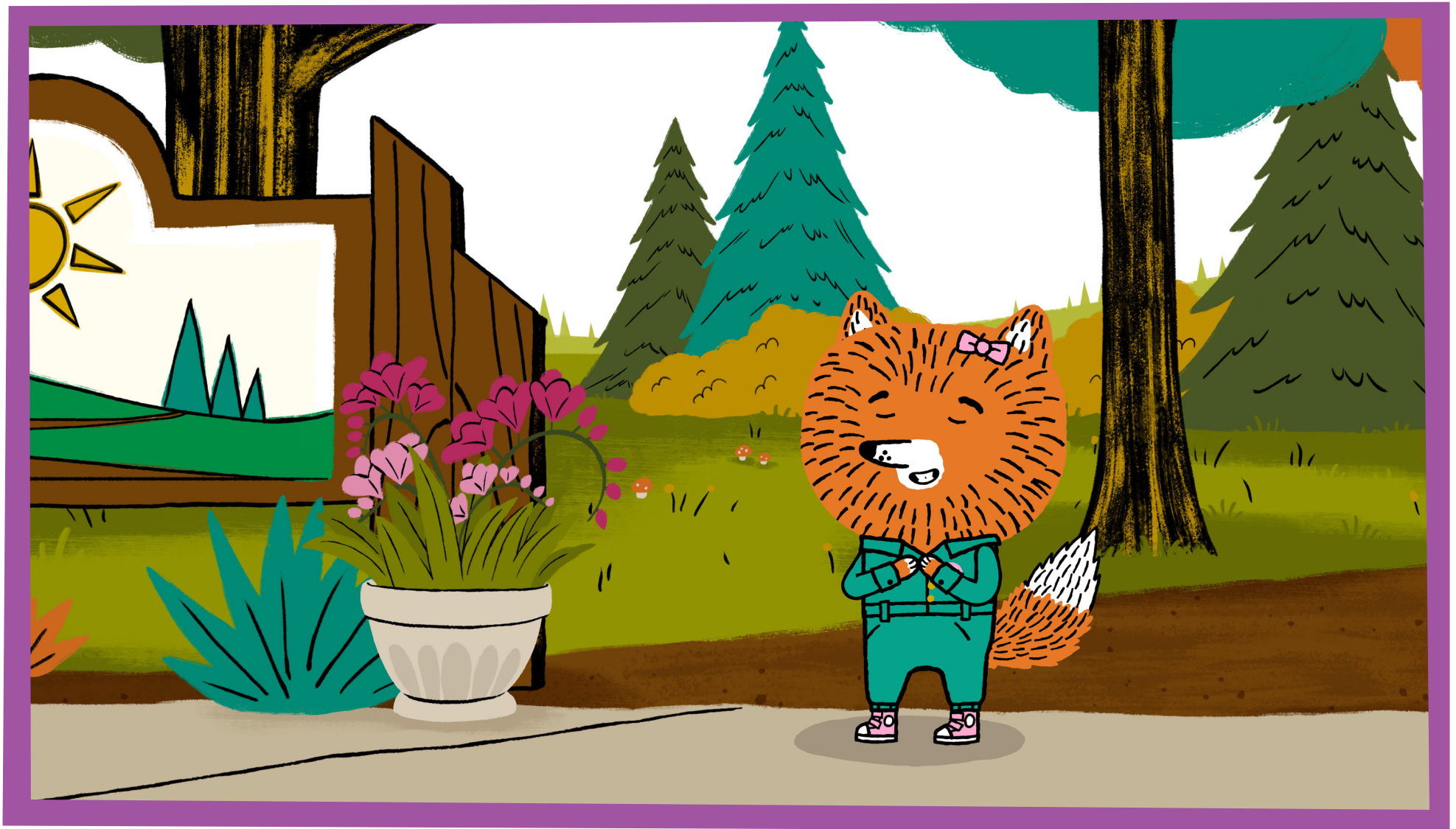
Learning about each other is one way to become friends.

It's okay if I take time to think about my answer.



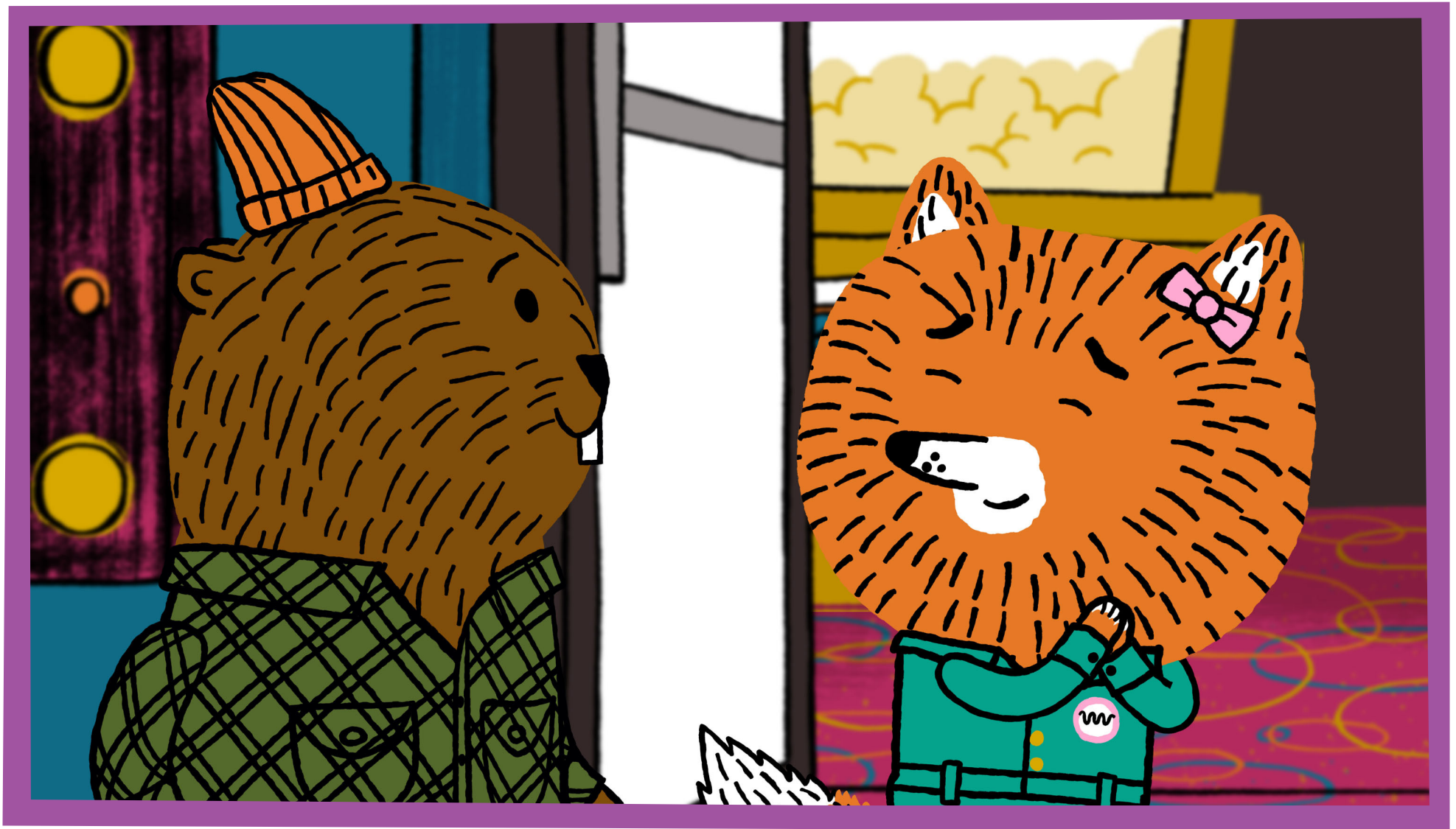
I can answer the question by telling them
